Eligibility Requirements:

All students, female and male, who meet the following requirements are encouraged to apply.

- You must be a current resident of the Arlington, Stanwood, Camano Island, Lakewood, or La Conner area OR be a graduate of Lakewood, Arlington, Stanwood, Lincoln Hill, or La Conner High Schools.
- You must have completed at least 2 years of study at an accredited college or university by June 2025 and have verifiable plans to continue upper-division or master's level post-graduate work at an accredited 4-year college or university in the fall of 2025.
- You must submit all items listed below for consideration.
- All submissions must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, April 30, 2025.

Application Requirements—include ALL of the following in your application envelope:

All submissions must be **postmarked on or before Tuesday, April 30, 2025.** Incomplete submissions, submissions that do not adhere to the directions below or submissions postmarked after April 30, 2025 cannot be considered. **Letters of recommendation must be mailed** <u>not emailed</u>.

- 1. Completed AAUW Stanwood-Camano Branch 2025 Scholarship Application Form (following page).
- 2. Official copy of ALL your college transcripts (no photocopies).
- 3. Two confidential letters of recommendation; mailed not emailed.
 - One from an instructor or counselor at your college or university and
 - One from a person in your high school or college community
 - Each inserted in a sealed envelope with the writer's signature on the flap
- 4. A 300-word essay written by you that describes your relationship to our mission. This hard copy document must be typed and double-spaced with one-inch margins all around. The word count must be noted at the top right hand corner of the page.
- 5. A brief personal statement written by you that describes:
 - Your future plans and goals,
 - Accomplishments and community contributions,
 - Current and past employment or volunteer work you've done,
 - Circumstances influencing your financial need, and
 - Any other information you want to include for the scholarship committee's consideration.
